The Golden Lions baseball program has an established history of success.

From 2000 through the 2008 season, the Golden Lions have won 147 games and lost only 103.

During that time, twelve young men have taken their skills to baseball programs at nine different colleges. In 2004, a player was selected in the Major League Baseball draft.

Camp Coaching Staff

Head Coach J.T. Gilbert will lead the camps. The 2009 season will be Coach Gilbert's sixth season as the head varsity coach, but eighth overall with the Golden Lions.

Coach Gilbert won three state championships as a player in high school, and then continued his playing career as a pitcher at the University of Minnesota. Prior to coming to St. Pius X, Coach Gilbert was the Pitching Coach at Viterbo University in LaCrosse, Wisconsin.

In addition to Coach Gilbert, the camp will utilize current and past standout high school and college players, as well as members of the current Golden Lions coaching staff.
