Criteria for Exempting Boys Golf Q-School Tryouts in 2008

Varsity lettermen from the 2007 State Runner-Up squad are exempt from Phase I and II of Q-School

Play-in Option A...the “Arduous” route

In order to join those players already exempt from the first two phases of Q-School '08, any SPX Golden Lion Golf candidate, regardless of past status or membership, must post eight 18-hole rounds at or below 85 strokes between June 1st, 2007 and January 15th, 2008. Additionally, exempted golfers must meet level “B” rules certification by January 15th, 2008 in order to validate their exemption.

Specifics about the eight rounds:

- 1) You must play with/have scores attested by one of the following people during each of your rounds: Coach Cook, Efrim Moore, Patrick Rudebeck, one of the four members of the SPX Golden Lion Golf Class of 2007 (Jarrod DeLoach, Jake Keen, Brent Modak, or Bud Pellicer), or one of the following members of the SPX Golden Lion Golf Alumni Group (Blake Parker '04, Joe Rogers '05). Over time, rounds should be played under the supervision of a variety of different supervisors, including one with Coach Cook. Additionally, any round played in an American Junior Golf Association, Georgia PGA Junior Series, Georgia State Golf Association, Southeastern Junior Tour, or a Plantations Junior Tour event that meets the requirements listed below will be certified.
- 2) Regardless of weather or particulars of course condition, you must play a course from 6,400 yards or greater, and the slope rating of the course must meet or exceed 127.
- 3) Although it should go without saying, you must hole out on all 18 holes...no “gimmies” and no “mulligans.” Waiving rules is grounds for disqualification from this process!!!
- 4) Straight USGA Rules of Golf are in effect.

Play-in Option B...the “Boom” route

Another exemption path rests with a golfer’s ability to compile a resume of remarkable summer and/or fall of junior golf competition. Any **ONE** of the following achievements can earn a Q-School '08 exemption:

- 1) Place in the top 20 overall in the Atlanta Junior Golf Association’s 2007 Grand Championship.
- 2) Place in the top ten overall in any Southeastern Junior Golf Tour event.
- 3) Place in the top eight overall in any Georgia PGA Series event.
- 4) Place in the top four twice in any Georgia State Golf Association Junior Sectional series event.
- 5) Make the cut at a USGA Junior Amateur Championship sectional qualifier or the GSGA Georgia State Junior Championship.
