In his 7th year as head coach at St. Pius X and 15th year as a high school soccer coach, Killebrew Bailey has established his expectations for the men's soccer program.

In his first six years Coach Bailey guided the team to 4 Region Championships (including 3 straight years undefeated in region play), two Final Four appearances, and five top ten finishes. His resume speaks for itself, holding the Varsity Boys' Soccer State Championship 1A-4A('00) in Alabama. He was named the Region 6AAAA Coach of the Year the previous two years. He was voted the Alabama Soccer Coach of the Year [1A-4A('00)] and All Metro Coach of the Year [1A-6A('00), Huntsville, Alabama].

He was chosen to coach All-State Soccer Team (99) Alabama, which is a high honor. He was the All-Metro Coach of the Year [1A-5A('99) Huntsville, Alabama] in addition to Coach of the Year at Randolph School in 1996. (Huntsville, Alabama). He currently holds a National Diploma from the NSCAA and a Certificate of Coaching from the KNVB, Dutch National Soccer Federation.

In her first year of coaching at St. Pius, coach Sara Geiger, lead the Lady Lions to a state championship game. The Lady Lions ended the season with a 20-2 record, racked up 130 goals, and demonstrated remarkable defense only allowing 9 goals to be scored.

Previous to Pius, Coach Geiger played four years of Division I soccer for the Samford bulldogs in Birmingham, Alabama. During those four years she accumulated numerous awards including Second Team All - OVC and All - OVC Tournament Team. She helped lead Samford to four straight back to back regular season conference championships and scored a penalty kick to send the bulldogs into the second round of the NCAA tournament.

Preceding her career at Samford, Geiger played for Parkview High School and Gwinnett Soccer Association. At Parkview, Geiger recorded two regional championships and a state championship her senior year. She scored the game winning goal in the state championship game in the last thirty seconds as fans were walking out of the stadium. Her performances awarded her the Gwinnett County Player of the Year in 2003 and she was named one of only two girls from Georgia as a NSCAA high school All - American. Along with high school accomplishments, Geiger's club team won the 2001 National Championship and finished third nationally in 2002 and 2003.

Coach Geiger was very pleased with her team last year, has established high expectations, and only hopes to continue the success in the years to come.

Middle School Tryouts

As we look forward to the 2009 soccer season, we are inviting all boys and girls interested in trying out for the St. Pius X middle school soccer teams to come out and join us on the following dates: Boys tryouts will be held January 24th and 25th from 5:00 to 7:00pm with girls tryouts on February 7th at 10:00am-12:00pm and the 8th at 1:00-3:00pm. Both tryouts will be held in the stadium on the campus of St. Pius X.

The Varsity boy's soccer teams have won six state championships in their illustrious history, with several more final four appearances. The past six years, the team has been lead by Coach Killebrew Bailey. The team finished undefeated in region play 3 of the past 4 years, and has never failed to reach the state playoffs! The team has been ranked in the top five of the state in AAAA competition 4 of the past 6 years with two trips to the final four. Most of our players on the varsity squad played on the middle school teams here at St. Pius X.

In the past eight years the Lady Lions have won 145 games, tied 14, and lost only 34. They have achieved a spot in the state championship seven times out of the past eleven years, while winning a total of three state championships. In 2008, the Lady Lions had tremendous success with a 20 - 2 record, scoring 130 goals, and only allowing 10 goals to be scored on them. They ended the excellent season in the state championship game losing in a heart breaking shoot out. This year the Lady Lions will continue playing under Coach Sara Geiger, who only hopes to top her successful first season with a state championship.

Much of our Varsity success comes from the success of our Middle School teams. The Boys' Middle School team has a winning percentage of over 90% and has had several years with no losses and even no goals allowed! The Girls' Middle School team has also achieved high success with several big wins and a development that promises to be demonstrated this year on the older St. Pius X teams.

Coach Sara Geiger (sgeiger@spx.org) and Coach Greg Raines will conduct Middle School Soccer tryouts for girls. Coach Matt Patria (jmpatria@bellsouth.net) will be the middle school boy's coach for his fourth season. Matt was an outstanding player at St. Pius X and won three State Championships in his career. Coach Patria, his assistants, and Coach Bailey will conduct Middle School Soccer tryouts for the boys.

Remember that this year, in order to tryout for the Middle School team, every player MUST have a physical on file with St. Pius. The forms can be found on the Pius athletics website, <http://www.spx.org/athletics>, click on the link at the top that says Athletic Forms. If a player does not have a physical on file, he or she will not be allowed to tryout. No exceptions!!! As always, if you have any questions, please feel free to contact the Middle School coaches via email. It is also a good idea to occasionally check the St. Pius X website (www.spx.org/athletics) for updates on times, locations, and possible changes.
