- 10/31/05-----Have *The Crucible* read or seen. We will begin to discuss it in class. You will receive two sets of study questions in class; they deal with theme and characterization. Notes on characterization are due Wednesday.

- 11/2/05-----Have written notes on the character you chose. They should include at least two quotations from each act in which your character appears. In class, we will begin the discussion of theme.
