

# Marching Band Class Syllabus 2007-08

Mr. Chad Paetznick – Band Director

The purposes of the St. Pius X band program are as follows:

- to help develop an aesthetic appreciation through the study and performance of musical literature.
- to aid in the development of individual responsibility and self-discipline.
- to further develop and enhance motor and cognitive skills
- to further school spirit.
- to represent the school and community in a positive manner.

## Course Description

Marching Band students will be engaged in a variety of music performances. Students are mainly responsible for learning all music and marching drill moves for the halftime contest show, and all pep song material. Halftime show music must be memorized. Students will have graded music work checks to test for memorization. **Home games, contests, and after-school rehearsals are required and are part of each student's weekly grade evaluation.**

Other material to be covered includes, but is not limited to..

- Major Scales / Key Signatures
- Time Signatures
- Rhythm Studies
- Articulation
- Dynamics
- Basic Music Theory

## Required Materials

Instrument, music, folder, flip-folder, pencil, cleaning cloth, accessories (sticks, mallets, reeds, valve oil, neckstraps, etc)

## Grading

Grades will be based on the following criteria:

Weekly Participation (prepared for class, amount of practice, attendance, and attitude)	30%
Performances (events, festival, concerts)	40%
Music Work checks (quizzes on scales, selected excerpts, memorization)	20%
Written and homework	10%

The following grading scale will be used:

90 – 108	=	A
80 – 89	=	B
74 – 79	=	C
70 – 73	=	D
Below 70	=	F
Incomplete	=	I

## Rules and Regulations

1. **Golden Rule: Treat others (teacher and students) as you would expect to be treated.**
2. **Gum, food, or drinks are not allowed in the band room. Do not chew or eat anything during any class or rehearsal. There may be exceptions for certain events.**
3. **I-pods, MP3 players, CD Players, video games are not to be out in any class or any rehearsal.**
4. **Enter the room with manners. Get out instruments and music and be ready to start. Do not play random notes or music out of turn.**
5. **Please do not ask to use the restroom except in the case of an emergency.**
6. **When class or rehearsal has started, immediately cease talking and/or warming up. Remain quiet throughout the rest of the rehearsal.**
7. **If you have a question or comment, raise your hand and wait to be recognized before speaking. Do not disrupt the director during rehearsals.**
8. **Always remember to make music (articulation, style, dynamics) and not just play notes.**
9. **Put instruments and music away and straighten up your area at the end of class or rehearsal. This includes trash, chairs, stands, etc.**
10. **Do not write on or deface any school property (music stands, instruments, lockers)**
11. **Practice at home. This is part of your required participation in band.**
12. **Do not miss required performance events or rehearsals.**

## Rehearsals and Performances:

The following rehearsals and performances are required unless otherwise directed by Mr. Paetznick. Make sure that these dates are on your calendar. **Absences will result in the lowering of grades.** Anyone who has a conflict with a required rehearsal or performance must speak to Mr. Paetznick about the conflict in advance. This may not necessarily excuse you from the event.

Parents, please do your best to **pick up your child in a timely manner after each rehearsal or event.**

### Symphonic Band Attire at performances:

Guys – Tux shirts, Pants, Jacket, Black Socks, Black Tux Shoes

Girls - Concert Dress, black hose, black dress shoes

**Anyone not in the proper uniform will not be allowed to perform with the band, and will receive a lowered grade for that performance. All students must stay for the duration of each performance.**

\*All band members may also purchase a green "performance day" polo shirt (\$20) to be worn at certain events, at school on the day of certain events, and before certain performances.

**Basketball Band** – Basketball band is a volunteer group open to any band member who is enrolled in band during basketball season. The group performs at several home varsity games at St. Pius. Service hours may be available for participating in this group. Members must learn all pep songs in order to be eligible for the group.

**Jazz Band** - Jazz Band will start some time second semester and run through Spring. The group will rehearse once a week after school, and perform at certain events to be announced.

### **Director's Office**

The director's office is off limits to students except for official business. Students must get permission to use the phone. Students may not use the director's computer.

### **Music**

Students will be responsible for keeping track of their own parts. Students may be charged .25 for each page of Xeroxed music lost. Students will be charged appropriate replacement costs for each page of **original** music lost. Some publishers will not sell individual parts; therefore, you may be buying a whole new set of music!

### **Instruments**

All band members are expected to keep their instruments, whether school-owned or privately-owned, clean and in working order. Periodically, Mr. Paetznick will give grades on condition of instruments. Students using school-owned instruments will be responsible for repairing any damage that they have caused. Students must also keep their instrument in one of the lockers in the band-room (when not at home) with a lock on it. **The combination for the lock (or extra key) must be given to Mr. Paetznick in case emergency access is needed.**

### Private Lessons

Each band member should strive to be the best player he or she can be. The fastest and best way to improve individual playing skills is to take private lessons. See Mr. Paetznick for a list of private teachers in the area. Mr. Paetznick will also be available on a few select days before and after school for help.
