

## Spring 2008 Latin II Honors Study Guide – Mrs. Deprey

### General information

- Final exam is 20% of overall average
- Covers stages 21-25 in the textbook and workbook
- 90 minutes for the exam
- Wednesday, May 21, 2008 – 10:15-11:45 a.m. - room 204
- Combination of multiple choice and matching

### Areas to study:

- Vocabulary and derivatives for stages 21-25; vocabulary from earlier stages may also appear in sentences related to grammar and translation
- Phrases and prefixes of the week from the start of the semester
- Review present active, perfect active and passive participles (stages 21-22)
- Imperfect and pluperfect subjunctives – all forms (stage 25)
- Uses of the subjunctive: indirect questions and cum clauses (stages 24-25, and text page 333)
- Review adjective forms (positive, comparative, superlative and irregulars) (pages 301-302)
- Review irregular verbs – page 321
- Terms: mood, voice, number, tense
- Cultural information from stages 24 and 25 in particular and workbook questions

### Types of questions:

- Most accurate translation into Latin and/or English
- Grammar questions about a reading passage
- Comprehension questions about a reading passage
- Basic knowledge about culture and grammar
- Vocabulary and derivatives definitions

### Materials to use:

- Textbook: each stage's "About the Language" section that covers a new grammar point and "Practicing the Language" to reinforce your skills
- Textbook: reread all the cultural information sections, particularly for stages 24-25, and reread all the stories from stage 21 to 25 to review grammar and vocabulary in context
- Workbook: go back through all the exercises completed for each stage
- Vocabulary lists and quizzes for each stage – pay attention especially to corrections
- Notes given in class on grammar and culture, and all old tests
- Indices in textbook: pages 296-297, 299, 301-302, 311, 315, 321, 324-325, 328-329, 333
