

Algebra III 27.26 Syllabus
Mr. Shuert

Content: We will study Modeling and Equation Solving, Functions (their properties and graphs), Graphical Transformations, Linear and Quadratic Functions, Power Functions, Polynomial Functions of Higher Degree, Complex Numbers, Rational Functions and Equations, Trigonometry, Logarithms, and Probability.

Students should expect homework on a daily basis and quizzes maybe given without notice!!!! Notes should be taken in class and will be checked randomly for a quiz grade. Homework will be graded on an effort basis. For each assignment ten points for 100% complete, five points for 50% or more, and no points for less than 50% will be given. Homework will not be taken late.

Grading: Students must use a pencil for tests and quizzes. There is a 20% deduction for failure to do this.

- **Quiz 20%**
- **Assignment 20%**
- **Exam 15%**

Materials: Students should bring paper, sharpened pencils, the pre calculus textbook, and a calculator to class.
