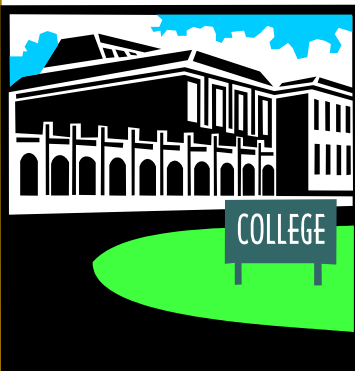

Essays serve as a measure of your writing abilities and provide information about your personal background that is not revealed through your application or transcript alone. Think of your application essay as an opportunity to demonstrate your uniqueness to colleges and stand out from your peers.
